
REGULATIONS

RESPECTING

A P P R E N T I C E S

AND

Hired and Indented Servants.

WHEREAS certain Rules and Regulations were made by his Majesty's Justices of the Peace at a General Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace, holden for the district of Montreal, on the 19th day of July, 1802, which rules and regulations were to have force and effect within the district of Montreal, under the authority of an Act of the Provincial Parliament passed in the 42d year of his Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act to empower the Justices of the Peace to make, for a limited time, Rules and Regulations for the Government of Apprentices and others." And whereas, from unforeseen causes, the said rules and regulations then made having been found insufficient and inadequate for the purposes for which they were originally intended, it is necessary and expedient to alter the same.

It is therefore Ordered and Resolved by his Majesty's Justices of the Peace at a General Quarter Sessions of the Peace begun and holden for the district of Montreal on Tuesday the tenth day of July, in the fiftieth year of his Majesty's reign, and continued by adjournments to Friday the 19th day of the same month.
