GRANTS MADE FOR REAL ESTATE RESEARCH
 Three grants totalling \$6,680 have been made to U of A staff members for research in topics relating to real estate.

Dr. Stanley Waterman, post doctoral fellow in geography, was awarded \$1,000 for "Quality and Ranking of Shopping Centres in Edmonton." Dr. Vladimir Salzyzn, assistant professor of economics, received \$1,280 for "Effects of Deferred Depreciation on Housing." D. G. Murri, assistant professor of agricultural economics and rural sociology, and Dr. V. B. Proudfoot, associate professor of geography, received \$4,400 for their project dealing with "The Industrial and Domestic Contribution to Taxes in Towns and Villages in Alberta."

Three projects made possible by earlier grants are still underway. These projects and their investigators are "Form and Function of Whyte Avenue, Edmonton," D. B. Johnson, assistant professor of geography; "Real Estate Salesmen's Compensation," David I. Forsyth, graduate student in business administration and commerce; and "An Analysis of Real Estate Sales Personnel," Professor R. H. Evans, Faculty of Business, the University of Calgary.
