DUNDAS June 24th, 1912

R.S. Muir nominated Provincial candidate with Wesley Hamilton, Dominion candidate are organizing thoroughly. They will have a card system and organized by concessions in each sub-division.

JUNE 24th

M.S. Beckstead, Secretary of the Association reports lists generally revised in September.

JULY 1st

M.S. Beckstead requests revision forms. Annual meeting of Association July 13th. Arrangements to be made to revise lists. Organizer W.F. Summerhayes is meeting the Executive. R.S. Muir also taking active part regarding lists etc.,

JULY 3rd

The Voters Lists will be thoroughly revised as follows:- R.F. Lyle, Barrister (an old resident of Morrisburg) will look after Morrisburg Village and Williamsburg Township; W.L. Redmond and C.E. Cameron will look after Iroquois and Matilda Township; Wesley Hamilton, Dominion Candidate, and W.B. Lawson, Barrister, will look after Chesterville, Winchester Village and Winchester Township and will attend to Mountain Township. None of the lists are yet posted up. W.F. Summerhayes attended annual meeting on July 13th, attendance not very large, but was representative of the workers, every Municipality being present. Dominion and Provincial candidates both attended and lists will be thoroughly revised. Revision forms were given out to the representatives of every Municipality present. Mr. Hamilton, Dominion Candidate, will make personal canvas of every voter and seems to be a good candidate. Dundas is anxious for a fight even at a bye-election and they are in good shape to fight. W.B. Lawson of Chesterville, former candidate and worker is in poor health and cannot be depended upon to do a great deal.

AUGUST 30th
