
Ottawa 1st December, 1902.

Sir,

I beg to inform you that the pay-sheet of the distribution of annuity for 1902 to the Indians of the Onion Lake Agency has been examined, and explanations are required in regard to the following, viz:-

No 24 Puskessahkeeweeins. There were no arrears due this Indian for 1898, as during that year there were seven persons to be paid under that number all of whom were paid five dollars each. It will therefore be necessary for five dollars to be refunded to the Department.
