The total amount missing is between 450 and 500 francs since the original investigation. There was about 450 francs in the box and a hundred franc notes on the buffet. A razor was missing, toothpaste and tooth brush, one comb, one cigar case with some cigars in it a cigarette case, one watch, one pair of gloves, and a bracelet made of various foreign coins.
