Dear Sir:- Re: Your File 14/28074.

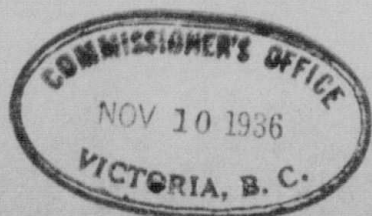
For years we had a Lease covering land in Indian Reserve No. 1 of the Ohiat Band, known as Numuckamis, the Lease number being 219. This Lease was taken up with the idea that it might be necessary in the event of us developing our iron property adjoining the Reserve. A very small portion of the iron deposit and the portal of the tunnel are on the Reserve. I think the Lease was cancelled in 1932.

I anticipate that with the return of better times it might be possible to do something with the property. I would therefore like to know the terms and conditions upon which you would be willing to grant a renewal of the Lease.
