

(b) that cases of a pipe line operated by a provincially incorporated company tapping a pipe line operated by a federally incorporated company be dealt with as they arose.

Appointment; Acting Minister of Finance

33. The Prime Minister submitted a recommendation to Council for the appointment of an Acting Minister of Finance pro tem.,

34. The Cabinet agreed that an Order in Council be passed appointing the Honourable J.J. McCann to act as Minister of Finance in the absence from Ottawa of the Minister and the Acting Minister.

Regulations respecting payments to municipalities for services in respect to non-taxable Crown property

35. The Minister of Finance reported that regulations had been prepared under which municipalities might be reimbursed for medical and hospital services provided employees and former employees of the Crown and their dependents, and dependents of members of the R.C.M. Police and the military forces, where there was liability arising out of residence of the persons concerned on non-taxable federal property. This payment had been approved in principle by Treasury Board who had referred the matter for consideration by Cabinet.

36. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved regulations providing certain payments to municipalities for services rendered in respect of non-taxable Crown property; Orders in Council to be passed accordingly.
