

Speers Reserve - Near the junction of
the Nicola and Speers Rivers.

Novitch Reserve. On the Nicola River
commencing near the mouth of the Speers
River and extending down the Nicola River
about 7 miles

Novitch Grass Reserve. About $\frac{3}{4}$ mile east
of the Novitch Reserve.

The Water Divisions set apart to the said
"Lower Nicola Indians" the following lie
altogether or partly within the 20 mile belts:

* 100 inches from the Marmel River ^{at its mouth}

* 225 " " " " ^{above the Speers River} Lower Nicola River

* 120 " " " " a stream about a mile east

from the Speers Reserve running
northwards to the lower Nicola River, also

from two small water courses running

from the south of the Reserve also

from all water sources within the

Reserve. (23rd July 1879)

* 00 " " " " " " " " " " " "

from all springs or water sources

within the Grass Reserve also from

the two streams which flow westwards

to the Lower Nicola River through

the Novitch Reserve. (26 August 1878)

* 225 " " " " " " " " " " " "

from a stream flowing eastwards into
