wherever encountered, as the smelters imposed a penalty, as they still do, for zine in excess of a certain per cent. in the mine product. But today some of the mines that have concentrators have been able to overcome this handicap by reason of milling machinery, which not only separates the higher values in lead and silver from the useless rock, but separates the zine as well, thus turning what has until lately been a detriment to the mine owner into a profitable by-product. And many are now looking confidently forward to the time when by some process, electric or otherwise, the still more complex ores of this region, of which there is an immense quantity, will be reduced to a marketable product, making for fifty mines in active operation for every one at the present time, with a corresponding prosperity increase for the town and district.
