

suspend any member whose conduct has been proved to be such as to bring the Club into disrepute, or to be at variance with the object of the Club, provided always that any such member whose conduct shall be brought before the notice of the Committee, shall receive a notice (of not less than ten (10) days previous to such meeting) of complaint having been made against him and enquiry to be made into the same. A majority of the Committee who shall vote by ballot, may declare said member suspended, and he shall be in consequence suspended, pending out the decision of the next General Meeting of the Club. A majority of said General Meeting shall declare the accused reinstated or expelled.

**13.**—Members shall be bound to aid and support the protection of Fish and Game in the Province of Quebec to the best of their ability and to report (in writing if possible) to the Secretary, President or a member of the Committee any infraction of the Fish and Game laws which may come under their observation, or to their knowledge.

**14.**—Any five members in good standing shall have power to cause the President or Secretary to call a Special Meeting of the members of the Committee, on making a requisition to that effect and stating the object for which the same shall be called.

**15.**—No discussion of any kind shall take place without the President's consent : except upon a motion made in writing, duly proposed and seconded.
