Our own Brains will do, if we have any; but Brains must be used, ours or someone else's, or the Mixture won't work right.

Potash and Phosphoric Acid should go on in the Fall—they are slow to dissolve. If put on now they get washed down and worked in, and ready for the roots to feed on first thing after the Winter's rest.

## POTASH

bleached Hardwood Ashes.

## NITROGEN

My Nitro-Bone Phos. may go on in the Fall with advantage, as the Nitrogen in it is a slow dissolver; but Nitrate of Soda and Sulphate of Ammonia should go on in the Spring. **STABLE MANURE.**—Don't waste it. Draw on every pound you can take, save or borrow. Then put on all you can buy of my Plant FOODS mentioned above, ad libitum.
