METROPOLITAN FASHIONS

To Take Measures for Patterns.

To Measure for a Lady's Basque or any Garment requiring a Bust Measure to be taken—Put the Measure around the body, over the dress, close under the arms, drawing it closely—not too tight.
 To Measure for a Lady's Skirt or any Garment requiring a Waist Measure to be taken—Put the Measure around the waist, over the dress.
 To Measure for a Lady's Sleeves—Put the Measure around the muscular part of the upper arm, about an inch below the lower part of the arm's-eye, drawing the tape closely—not too tight.
 Take the Measures for Misses' and Little Girls' Patterns the same as for Ladies'. In ordering, give the ages also.

To Take Measures for Patterns (Continued).

To Measure for a Man's or Boy's Coat or Vest—Put the Measure around the body, under the Jacket, close under the arms, drawing it closely—not too tight. In ordering for a boy, give the age also.
 To Measure for a Man's or Boy's Overcoat—Measure about the breast over the garment the coat is to be worn over. In ordering for a boy, give the age also.
 To Measure for a Man's or Boy's Trowsers—Put the Measure around the body, over the trousers; fit the waist, drawing it closely—not too tight. In ordering for a boy, give the age also.
 To Measure for a Man's or Boy's Shirt—For the size of the neck, measure the exact size where the neck-band encircles it, and allow one inch—thus, if the exact size be 14 inches, select a Pattern marked 15 inches. For the breast, put the measure around the body over the vest, under the jacket or coat, close under the arms, drawing it closely—not too tight. In ordering a Boy's Shirt Pattern, give the age also.


LITTLE BOYS' SAILOR SUIT.
 No. 8128.—Very jaunty is this suit, the pattern of which is in 7 sizes for little boys from 2 to 4 years of age. To make the suit for a boy of 5 years, will require $3\frac{1}{4}$ yards of material 27 inches wide, or $1\frac{3}{4}$ yard 54 ins. wide. Price of pattern, 25 cts.



LITTLE BOYS' APRON.
 No. 8135.—Plaid gingham is represented in this apron. The pattern is in 6 sizes for little boys from 1 to 6 years old. For a boy of 4 years, the apron calls for $2\frac{3}{4}$ yards of material 27 inches wide, or 2 yards 36 ins. wide. Price of pattern, 20 cts.





LADIES' JACKET-BASQUE. (KNOWN AS THE LOUIS XV. COAT.) (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 8136.—This pattern is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches bust measure. For a lady of medium size, the basque requires $8\frac{1}{2}$ yards of velvet and $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of satin each 20 inches wide, $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of chiffon 45 inches wide, $2\frac{1}{4}$ yards of ribbon 8 inches wide, and $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards of ribbon 6 inches wide. Of one material, it needs $9\frac{1}{2}$ yards 22 inches wide, or 7 yards 30 inches wide, or $5\frac{3}{4}$ yards 36 inches wide, or $5\frac{1}{4}$ yards 44 inches wide, or $4\frac{3}{4}$ yards 50 inches wide. LITTLE BOYS' DRESS.

No. 8129.—This dress has a box-plaited skirt and sailor collar. The pattern is in 6 sizes for little boys from 2 to 7 years of age. To make the dress for a boy of 4 years, will require $3\frac{1}{4}$ yards of white and $\frac{3}{8}$ yard of blue flannel 27 inches wide. Of one material, it needs 4 yards 27 ins. wide. Price of pattern, 20 cts.



GIRLS' COAT. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 8173.—The pattern of this coat is in 8 sizes for girls from 5 to 12 years of age. For a girl of 8 years, the garment requires $5\frac{3}{4}$ yards of material 22 inches wide, or $3\frac{1}{2}$ yards 36 inches wide, or $2\frac{3}{4}$ yards 44 inches wide, or 2 yards 54 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cents.



LADIES' JACKET-BASQUE, WITH FANCY OR PLAIN SEPARATE VEST. (KNOWN AS THE LOUIS XV. COAT.) (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 8151.—This pattern is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches bust measure. For a lady of medium size, it requires $7\frac{3}{4}$ yards of velvet 20 inches wide, with $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of chiffon 45 inches wide, and $2\frac{1}{4}$ yards of edging 6 inches wide. Of one fabric, it needs $7\frac{3}{4}$ yards 22 inches wide, or $5\frac{3}{4}$ yards 30 inches wide, or $4\frac{3}{4}$ yards 36 inches wide, or $3\frac{3}{4}$ yards 44 ins. wide. Price of pattern, 30 cents.

GIRLS' CIRCULAR, RIPPLE CAPE, WITH HOOD. (IN RED RIDING-HOOD STYLE.) (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 8175.—This pattern is in 10 sizes for girls from $\frac{1}{2}$ to 9 years of age. For a girl of 8 years, the cape requires $2\frac{5}{8}$ yards of material 22 inches wide, or 2 yards 30 inches wide, or $1\frac{5}{8}$ yard 36. 44 or 54 inches wide, with $2\frac{3}{4}$ yards of silk to line. Price of pattern, 20 cts.
