Resolved that the bill do pass, and Ordered that Mr. *Smith*, and Mr. *Miles*, carry the said bill to the Council and desire their concurrence thereto.

A Message from His Majesty's Council.

Mr. Justice *Chipman*, delivered the following Message :---

" Mr. *Speaker*,

" I am directed to inform this House, that Mr. Justice *Chipman*, is appointed a Committee to meet such Committee as the House of Assembly may appoint, to wait upon His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, to request that he will be pleased to transmit to His Majesty the joint Address on the subject of the Boundary."

And then Mr. Justice *Chipman* withdrew.

Ordered that Mr. *Parker* and Mr. *Fraser*, be a Committee to join the Committee of Council, and further ordered that they inform the Council of their appointment.

A bill " to repeal an Act, to alter and in addition to An Act for establishing a Tender in all payments to be made in this Province."

A bill " in amendment of An Act for regulating, laying out and repairing Highways and Roads."

A bill " to continue and revise the Revenue Laws of the Province."
