**PRAYERS.**

Read the proceedings of Saturday.

On motion, the bill intituled "An act to ascertain and establish the Boundary Lines of the several Counties and Townships of this Island, and to regulate Surveyors,"—received a third reading, and passed, and was ordered to be sent down to the House of Assembly for their concurrence.

A message from the House of Assembly, by *Mr. Owen* :

"Mr. President—The House of Assembly have passed a bill intituled "An act to amend an act intituled an act to render perpetual an act intituled an act to enable the Justices of the Supreme Court of Judicature to issue Commissions for examining Witnesses out of this Island."—to which they pray the concurrence of his Majesty's Council;—The House of Assembly have also passed a bill intituled "An act to regulate the introduction of Passengers in Vessels arriving in this Island,"—as amended by the committees of both Houses.

On motion, the bill intituled "An act to continue an act made and passed in the 9th year of his present Majesty, intituled an act to continue and alter an act made and passed in the 8th year of his present Majesty, intituled an act to revive, alter and continue an act made and passed in the 6th year of his present Majesty's reign, intituled an act for increasing the Revenue by levying a Duty on Tobacco and Tea, and to appropriate the monies hereby granted:"—also, the bill intituled "An act to continue and amend an act made and passed in the 9th year of his present Majesty, intituled an act to continue and alter an act made and passed in the 8th year of his present Majesty's reign, intituled an act to revive, alter and continue an act made and passed in the 6th year of his present Majesty's reign, intituled an act for increasing the Revenue by levying an additional Duty on all Wines, Gin, Brandy, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors imported into this Island, and to repeal and amend certain parts of an act passed in the 25th year of his late Majesty's reign, intituled an act to amend, render more effectual, and to reduce into one act the several Laws made by the General Assembly of this Island relative to the Duties of Impost on Wines, Rum, Brandy, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, and for allowing a Drawback upon all Wines, Rum, Brandy, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors exported from this Island, and to appropriate the monies hereby granted:"—also, the bill intituled "An act to indemnify the Treasurer of this Island and all other persons concerned in paying certain monies on Warrants issued since the last Session of the General Assembly,"—received a second reading.
