London, Sept. 11.—(New York Times)—The London Gazette announces the awarding of the Victoria Cross to twenty officers, non-commissioned officers, and men for extraordinary courage and self-sacrifice displayed by Private W. McPadden, late of the Royal Irish Rifles, in the capture of Orsova, a strategic point on the Danube, in the face of a bombardment which killed and wounded many of the British troops.

The impression produced by capture of Orsova, obliterates news of the fall of Turtukai, which the fighting has been of the most obstinate character and the loss very heavy on both sides. True, brave resistance made by the Romanian troops, which had not hitherto been under fire against the German forces, of Bulgarians and Rumanians, whose attacks continued.
