#### New College Building To Be Erected

**Larger and More Modern Edifice to Take Place of St. Thomas' College Recently Destroyed by Fire**

Chatham, March 17—At a largely attended meeting of Catholics in the Knights of Columbus Hall, Sunday evening, it was unanimously decided to erect a new college building to take the place of St. Thomas' College recently destroyed by fire. A strong committee was appointed to institute a drive throughout the diocese which embraces all of Northumberland, Gloucester, Restigouche, Madawaska, and part of Kent County for the purpose of raising \$25,000. The support of the diocese of St. John will also be asked, thus making the drive Province-wide. It is felt that the amount can in this way be easily raised. With the insurance on the burned building, \$27,000, and the proceeds of the drive on hand, the Bishop will go ahead with the work of construction. The work would be immediately commenced were it not that the completion of the upper part of the Cathedral (interior) is in progress, calling for the expenditure of about \$60,000 on contracts already let for which about half of the amount is on hand and provision will have to be made for the balance. Under the circumstances the completion of the Cathedral calls for first consideration. The raising of the funds for the new college is entirely in the hands of the laity, as the Bishop does not feel, in view of the large amount required to finish the Cathedral, he could conscientiously ask his priests to assist in raising funds for a cause that is not exclusively church work. The new building will cost at least \$80,000. It will be modern in every respect and will be erected on a new site on the college grounds. #### Cannibal Orgy In West Africa

Several Bodies Eaten and Towns Laid Waste

New York, March 19—Details of a cannibal orgy in West Africa in which natives are reported to have eaten members of opposing tribes after a battle, were received by the Presbyterian board of missions last night in a message from Dr. Gayland Bealand, of Louisville, Ky., a missionary stationed at Smet, West Africa. According to Dr. Bealand, fighting centred about a native King at the town of Bupup, whose forces were attacked by those of several elder chiefs after he had ordered the erection of a school for use of the missionary party in his town. Several bodies were eaten in the streets.

Later, after twelve of the insurgent chiefs had been captured and imprisoned by French troops, and the uprising quelled, Dr. Bealand visited the scenes of other fights. According to his report nearly a dozen towns had been laid waste and the road over which he travelled was strewn with human bones from which the flesh had been eaten. Dr. Bealand and his associates promptly began re-organizing the mission work in the destroyed towns and he reported that the horrors of the uprising caused a revivification of feeling among the natives which resulted in hundreds of conversions and baptisms.
