Germany Has a Marriage Crisis.

Berlin, Nov. 21.—Germany which for some time past has been expressing alarm at the falling birth rate, has discovered a new sign of social decadence. It is the "marriage crisis." Latest statistics show an extraordinary rise in the number of divorces obtained in Germany. For instance 15,780 divorces were obtained in 1911 or 20 per 100,000 inhabitants against 12,180 or 20 per 100,000 in 1906. It is believed that when the next set of statistics is published a further increase in the number will be reported. What makes the marriage crisis all the worse is that while the number of divorces is rapidly increasing the number of marriages is decreasing. The number of marriages per 100,000 inhabitants in 1906 was 8,200 in 1911, 7,6000.
