## "TOADSTOOL" VICTIMS

Fourteen Dead Within the Last Few Days Around New York.

[Canadian Press.] New York, Sept. 8.—Deaths from eating poisonous mushrooms or "toadstools" continue in this city and in the vicinity, despite numerous warnings since the first victim succumbed early in the week. The death record yesterday was fourteen.

Mary D. Salvo, who died in the hospital today, is the third member of that family to be killed by eating of the poisonous fungi. The two surviving members may not recover.

Sunday and the Labor Day holiday are supposed to have had much to do with this unprecedented record. Warm weather, following long rains, brought out a profuse crop of mushrooms, and the holidays gave the victims opportunity to go into the fields and pick them.

NEW ENGLAND TRAGEDY. New Boston, Conn., Sept. 8.—John Criss is dead, and Peter Pony is dying from gunshot wounds, which the police allege were inflicted by Randolph Brissette, now under arrest. The police say that Brissette applied for admission to the boarding house, where all lived, and when refused, because of his condition, rang the doorbell, and then had outside and gave Criss and Pony each the contents of a barrel when they appeared to answer the bell. Criss is survived by a wife and family in Massachusetts, and Pony has a family here. All concerned are busy workers.
