MANY NEW GOLFERS PLAYING SATURDAY

Matches Mark Season's Opening For London Hunt Ladies' Golf Club.

Weather man proving kind, Saturday promises to be a gala occasion for the London Hunt Ladies' Golf Club, and also one of interesting revelations. Saturday is to be the real opening day for the season, though the links have enjoyed an unprecedented popularity among fair players for the past month, while the enthusiasts have been improving their game ever since the bridges were replaced and other ravages of the big storm of the end of March repaired.

Saturday the first matches of the season will be played and the first opportunity afforded to judge of the promise of an exceptionally large number of absolutely new 1922 golfing recruits.

Special prizes, one for each, for approach and putting, have been offered by Mrs. Marshall Graydon. In addition, there will be as many four-some matches as numbers will permit, and the officers are hoping to start the day bright and early, getting as many of these as possible played off in the forenoon. Though the men are playing in Sandwich that day, it is probable several masculine golfers will be at home and desirous of enjoying the links in the afternoon, hence a special effort on the part of the ladies to play off before luncheon.

The luncheon is to be the first rally affair of the kind for the club this year, and members are reminded that if they intend to be there they are expected to have their names down before Friday evening.

Special interest attaches to the Saturday matches from the fact they

will give an idea of who will be in the running for the Ontario championship matches to be played off at the Rosedale links, Toronto, in June. After the interest aroused by entertaining the tournament at the London Hunt last year, a number are looking forward to qualifying to participate this season, and possibly working up for the Canadian matches later. It is expected that at least eight will represent the London Hunt Ladies' Golf Club, and it is probable this number will be augmented.

PHILADELPHIA, May 18.—Returns from 7,543 districts out of 7,934 election districts in Pennsylvania in Tuesday's primary show a majority of 8,027 for Gifford Pinchot for the Republican gubernatorial nomination over Attorney-General George Alter. Pinchot's election this morning was conceded by his opponents. He is representative of the independent progressive wing of the party while Alter had the indorsement of the state Republican organization.

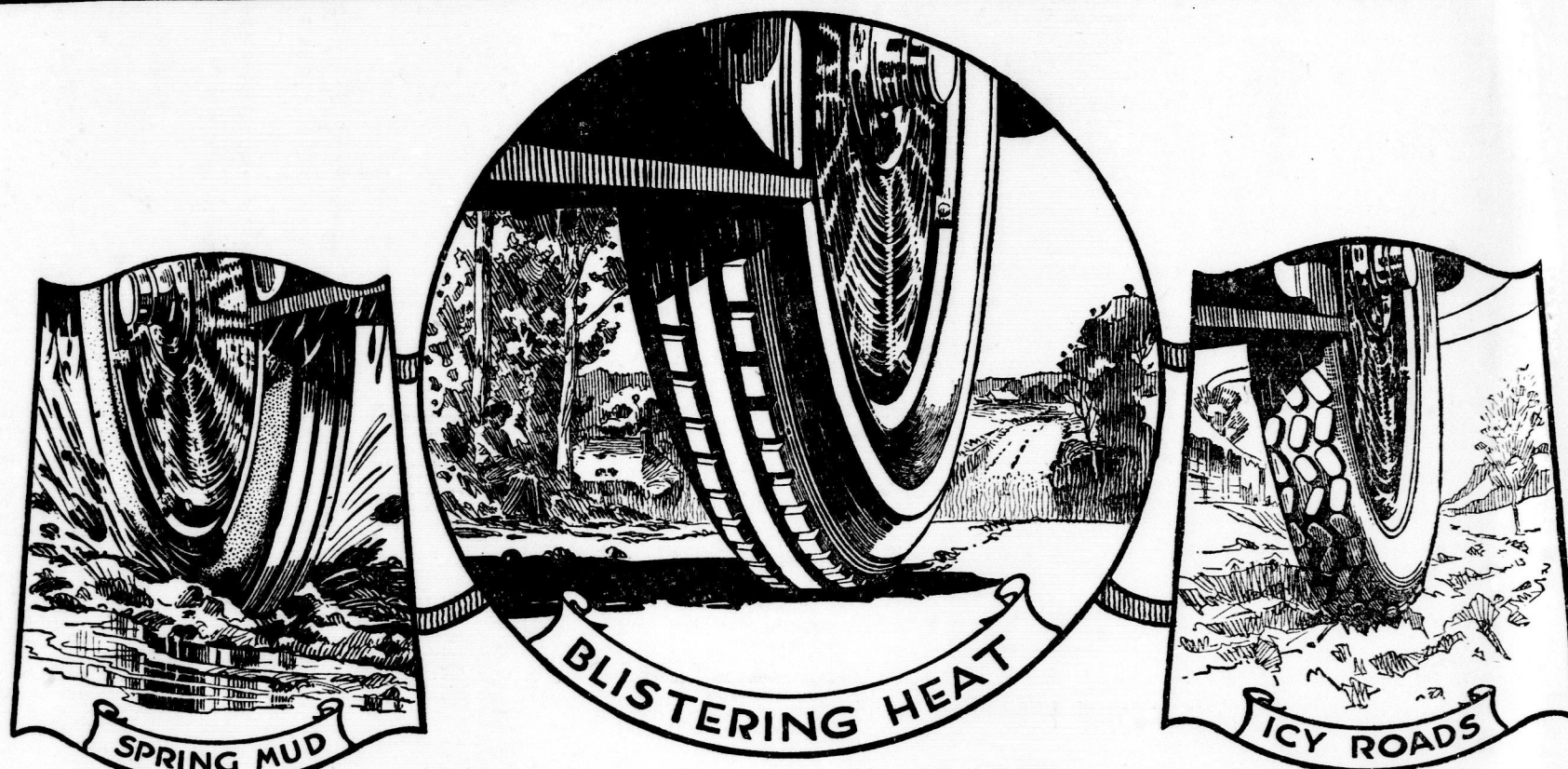
