ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY YEARS BEFORE, that Jerusalem capitulate I to the Turks? A permanent body of twenty-three members has been elected to sit in Vienna as the nucleus of this movement; £10,000,000 is proposed to be collected to start a bank, with its head office, I believe, in London, for the purpose of furthering the industrial, agricultural and mercantile interests of the Jewish colonies in the Holy Land, and circulars are already being sent to every Jewish community in the world, inviting contributions for that purpose, and fixing a shekel per head as the minimum.

Ezekiel, the prophet, tells us that Israel, on its return to Palestine, will rebuild the Temple at Mount Zion. AT THIS MOMENT THE WORK HAS ALREADY BEGUN. NOI, of course, in Jerusalem, but for some years past wealthy Jews have foreseen what was coming, and orders have been, and are being, quickly executed in England, Italy and elsewhere for this purpose. R ch marble carvings are being done in Italy, viought iron and metal work is being produced in England, together with o her things of various kinds. When the land is in the hands of its RIGHTFUL OWNERS these things can be rapidly shipped to Palestine and carried by new railways to Jerusalem.
