INDIGO.

The indigo made at the European factories in Lower Bengal is considered the most valuable, as they are more careful in the process of manufacture keeping the vats in which the indigo plants are fer mented as free as possible from weeds sand and impure water. The indigo seed is usually sown in March or beginning of April The plants grow rapidly and when the flower buds begin to bloom in July the first cutting commences, which is the best After about two months a second cutting is made, then a third. After the first cutting the value diminishes. Indigo varies much in quality and it requires a great deal of experience and practical testing in order to become a good judge of its real value
