POST PREPARED A LIST OF KNOWN IRAQI DEBTS OWED TO CANADIAN FIRMS/BANKS WITH OBJECTIVE OF PRESENTING THESE CASES TO IRAQI SIDE OF JOINT COMMISSION SO THAT REPAYMENT/RESCHEDULING COULD BE EXPEDITED; (02) AFTER DECISION TO CLOSE IRAQ TO SECTION 31 FINANCING, POST PREPARED AN EXTENSIVE LIST OF CONTRACTS EXCEEDING 550 MILLION DOLLARS WHICH MAY HAVE BEEN LOST AS A RESULT OF THIS DECISION; (03) ALSO CAUSED BY CLOSURE OF SECTION 31 FINANCING FOR IRAQ, POST WAS REQUIRED TO PREPARE NUMEROUS REPORTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING VARIOUS POLICY OPTIONS FOR CANADA'S TRADE PROGRAM WITH IRAQ. (04) TID PROGRAM MANAGER ACTED AS CHARGE D'AFFAIRES IN JANUARY IN THE ABSENCE OF THE HEAD OF MISSION.
