## **Organization and Implementation**

## Organization

- The Director of the Access to Information and Privacy Protection Division (the ATIP Office of the Department) has been delegated full authority to exercise the powers of the Access to Information Act and the Privacy Act.
- The ATIP Director reports to the Director General of the Executive Services Bureau. In addition to the ATIP Director, the Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs, the Deputy Minister for International Trade, and the Director General of the Executive Services Bureau are also designated with full powers, and all Heads of Mission are designated to act under Section 8(2)(m) of the *Privacy Act*.
- In addition to the Director, the ATIP Office has a complement of seven officers, three support staff and various consultants, all of whom are dedicated to access, privacy and directly related issues on a full-time basis. The mix of rotational foreign service and non-rotational specialist staff reflects an appropriate balance between broad ATIP experience and detailed knowledge of the policies and workings of a large and multi-faceted Department.
- The estimates of salary and operations for the ATIP Office found in the statistical record included in this report combine figures for operations under both the Access to Information Act and the Privacy Act since a breakdown for each Act is not practical.
