

John Manley, Minister of Foreign Affairs, will visit Halifax and Montreal from March 6 to 8, 2001. On Tuesday, March 6, in Halifax, the Minister will meet with students and professors from the Political Science and International Development Studies Departments of Saint Mary's University for a general discussion on Canadian foreign policy and current priorities. In the evening, he will participate in a departmental roundtable with academics, business people and NGO representatives.

In Montreal on March 8, Minister Manley will meet with Normand Legault, the president of the Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal. The Minister will do a live interview, followed by a call-in from members of the public, with Jean Lapierre of CKAC radio on the Summit of the Americas and foreign affairs more generally. In the evening, the Minister will attend a departmental outreach dinner before returning to Ottawa.

The Minister's program will be supplemented with political events.
