MINISTER PAT CARNEY COMPLETES OFFICIAL VISIT

TO HONG KONG

The Honourable Pat Carney, Minister for International Trade, has completed her first official visit to Hong Kong as Minister for International Trade. This visit followed the Minister's participation at the Quadrilateral Trade Ministers' Meeting held in Tokyo, Japan.

Miss Carney met with Mr. Hamish McLeod, Hong Kong Secretary of Trade and Industry. During this meeting, the Minister reviewed Canada/Hong Kong trade relations and discussed the progress being made on Canada/U.S. free trade negotiations as well as the preparations for the new round of Multilateral Trade Negotiations scheduled to take place over the next four vears.

Miss Carney also discussed developments at the recent Quadrilateral Trade Ministers' Meeting, noting the clear commitment of Ministers from Canada, Japan, the European Communities and the U.S. to fight protectionism in this period of world trade tension through closer economic cooperation. Canada and Hong Kong also agreed to work together in promoting progress in the new GATT round.

The Minister also gave a major address on Canada -Hong Kong trade and investment to the Hong Kong Canadian Chamber of Commerce. "I am here to urge Hong Kong business people to invest their energy and money in Canada," said the Minister, "and I will encourage Canadians to invest their energy and money in your exciting economy."
