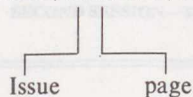


GUIDE TO THE USERS

This Index is a subject-based and cross-referenced index which provides subject analysis as well as corresponding entries under the names of individual Members of Parliament.

Each participating Member and witness has a global entry, based on the order of reference that covers all pages where he/she spoke.
