The provinces of British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland entered into agreements in 1957-58 for assistance in the construction of forest access roads and trails during the period January 2, 1958 to June 30, 1958. With the exception of Prince Edward Island, agreements were entered into with the same provinces in 1958-59 for assistance during the period November 1, 1958 to June 30, 1959. The amounts paid to each province in each fiscal year are shown in the following table:
