ECLIPSES.

There will be two Eclipses of the Sun this year, and two of the Moon; those of the Moon only being visible.

I.—April 5th, the Sun will be totally eclipsed, but

II.—April 20th, in the morning there will be a partial Eclipse of the Moon, magnitude 8,544 digits, or or over two-thirds on the Northern Limb. At Montreal it begins at 2h. 40m., middles 4h. 10m., and ends 5h. 43m.

III.—September 28th, an Annual Eclipse of the Sun occurs, but it will not be visible in this country.

IV.—Octr. 13th, in the evening, a partial Eclipse of the Moon will take place visibly. Magnitude, 11,976 digits on the Southern Limb. This Eclipse begins before the Moon rises here, and therefore will rise (5.15) with the Eclipse upon it. At Montreal this Eclipse middles at 6h, and ends 7h, 34m.

Venus will be the Morning Star until July 19th then Evening Star until May 10th, 1857.

Mars will be Morning Star until April 1st, then Evening Star until July 7th 1857.
