liable to three years' imprisonment who unlawfully wounds or inflicts any grievous bodily harm upon any other person, either with or without any weapon or instrument. (Code, sec. 242.)

Shooting at His Majesty's Vessels, and Wounding Public Officers on Duty.—Every one is guilty of an indictable offence and liable to fourteen years' imprisonment who wilfully—

(a) shoots at any vessel belonging to His Majesty or in the service of Canada; or (b) maims or wounds any public officer engaged in the execution of his duty or any person acting in aid of such officer. (Code, sec. 243.)
