

liable to three years' imprisonment who unlawfully *wounds* or *inflicts any grievous bodily harm* upon any other person, either with or without any weapon or instrument. (Code, sec. 242.)

**Shooting at His Majesty's Vessels, and Wounding Public Officers on Duty.**—Every one is guilty of an indictable offence and liable to fourteen years' imprisonment who wilfully—

(*a*) shoots at any vessel belonging to His Majesty or in the service of Canada; or (*b*) maims or wounds any public officer engaged in the execution of his duty or any person acting in aid of such officer. (Code, sec. 243.)
