NOTE.

I delivered the following sermons without expecting them to be printed. This has been requested by the church under my care, and in hope of their being serviceable when read, I comply with the request. They now appear as nearly in the form in which they were delivered from the pulpit as my notes and recollections allow of their being made. They contain not a discussion of the whole subject of which they treat, but a selection of topics and arguments for two baptismal services occurring in the ordinary course of my ministry.
