THE EXTRA ESTIMATES

Nearly Three Million Dollars Appropriated

OVER A MILLION FOR MILITARY

Canadian Marksmen to Have Permanent Quarters at Bisley.

Eight thousand to be spent on Dominion Government Buildings at Toronto.

Another \$10,000 for Burlington (Pier-Goderich, Kincardine, Kingsville and Collingwood) Each Gets a Big Share.

\$200,000 for the Behring Sea Commissioners and \$75,000 for Boundary Demarcation.

Ottawa, Sept. 25.—(Special.)—The supplementary estimates for the current fiscal year were brought down to-night.

The total to be voted is \$2,885,875, of which \$1,719,015 is charged to capital and \$1,170,841 to consolidated fund.

Over one million dollars goes for militia equipment. Bisley men will be glad to hear that permanent quarters are to be erected for them at a cost of \$500,000.

ONTARIO ALLOTMENTS.

Following are the Ontario appropriations:

Toronto-Dominion Public Buildings, Improvements, renewals, repairs, etc., \$800,000.

Ottawa-Public buildings, renewals of boilers in eastern block, \$500,000.

Arnprior-Fosterhouse, Custom House, etc., under contract, \$10,000.

Kingsville-Custom House, alterations to existing apparatus, \$10,000.

Ottawa-Grounds, public buildings, new sidewalks and roadways, \$17,000.

Burlington-Channel-Repairs to piers, \$10,000.

Cobourg-Repairs to piers, \$300,000.

Berkeley-Reconstruction of breakwater and repairs to piers, \$23,000.

Kincardine-Repairs to piers, \$15,000.

Collingwood-Repairs to landing pier, \$10,000.

Original-Reconstruction of wharf, \$1,500.

Port Burwell-Improvement of harbor, provided interested parties expend a sum of \$50,000, \$15,000.

River Thames-Dredging at the mouth of \$60,000.

North Channel-Repairs to Wharf, \$10,000.

Collingwood-Harbor-Improvements of \$20,000.

River-Improvement of navigable channel, \$15,000.

THE CANALS.

Under the heading of canals the following items appear:

North Channel-Deepening, widening and straightening, \$100,000.

Corwall Canal-Improvement, \$10,000.

Galopie Canal-Enlargement, \$100,000.

Murray Canal-Equipment, \$50,000.

Sault Ste. Marie-Construction and equipment (work actually performed), \$125,000.

Among the miscellaneous items is a vote of \$12,000 to extend the Government telegraph line to the town of Belle Isle, \$50,000 is voted to cover the expenses of the Behring Sea Commission, and \$200,000 to delimit the boundary between Canada and the States.

No appropriation appears for the Dominion Exhibition at Toronto, but this does not imply the intention of the Government not to grant the sum of \$500,000, as it could be voted next session.

MARKING OF CHEESE.

Mr. Fisher introduces a Bill to Make it Compulsory to Mark in Committee of Supply—Supplementary Estimates.

Ottawa, Sept. 25.—(Special.)—At the outset of to-day's sitting Mr. Fisher, Minister of Agriculture, introduced a bill to amend the Dairy Products Act by providing for compulsory marking of cheese with place and name of manufacturer.

The bill was in the main that introduced by Mr. McLenan (the Geary). He did not expect the measure to get through this session, but it could be introduced and printed so that ample opportunity would be afforded those interested to discuss its proposals during recess.

Mr. Haggart asked if the opinion of the Minister of Justice had been taken as to the legality of such an act.

Mr. Fisher replied that it had not, taking it for granted that the principle was legal by the present Act. He would discuss the matter of an address privately with the leader of the opposition.

Mr. McLenan urged the immediate passage of the bill, pointing out the necessity for it and the evidence there was of a preponderance of opinion throughout the country in favor of compulsory branding. The bill was given its first reading.

ADDRESS TO THE QUEEN.

Mr. Fisher presented to the Premier the advisability of Parliament adopting an address congratulating Her Majesty on having entered upon the 50th year of her reign.

Mr. Laurier replied that he would discuss the matter of an address privately with the leader of the opposition.

COMMITTEE OF SUPPLY.

In Committee of Supply Col. Gladstone brought up the question of cancellation of militia clothing contracts.

He read fully into the subject and showed the advantages accruing under the two and three-year contract system, quoting from papers brought down, he showed that the Department of Justice did not advise the cancellation of those contracts.
