Wheat Bought at That Figure in the Northwest.

FURTHER DROP IN CHICAGO

Winnipeg, Oct. 22.—(Special.)—The drop in wheat prices in Chicago does not affect the Manitoba market. The farmers there the wheat in the grain is getting from 10c to 12c a bushel more for their wheat than the farmers in Minnesota and Dakota. Yesterday at Qu'Appelle wheat was bought at \$1 a bushel.

The Panic in Chicago.

Late in the day there was a recovery and the highest point during the morning session was 74 1/4c. Towards the closing hour the slump was so rapid that the drop of a cent and more found no bidders. The price went from 73c to 71 1/4c, in five minutes. The scenes in the pit were such as had been witnessed in the history of the Board of Trade. There was a frantic rush of sellers on the strength of a rumor that Armour had sold his holdings. Thousands of bushels were dumped on the market, but there were no buyers who could keep pace with the quantity offered. There were some heavy losses. THE GOVERNMENT IS WEAK.

Such is the Opinion Expressed by Sir Charles Tupper.

CHAT WITH THE EX-PREMIER

Who Has Returned to the Capital in Good Health and Spirits.

Sir Charles Found the Conservatives of the Maritime Provinces in Good Heart and Prepared to Work Enthusiastically for the Overthrow of the Government When the Opportunity Presents Itself—Preparing for the Toronto Convention.

Ottawa, Oct. 22.—(Special.)—Sir Charles Tupper returned to the capital after a trip to Halifax and St. John, N.B., for the purpose of reorganizing the Liberal-Conservative party. Sir Charles was found in his study busily engaged with his private secretary. He was looking exceedingly well, and seemed to have enjoyed his trip, despite the fact that he was hard at work all the time.

"I held meetings," he said, "both in Halifax and St. John. In both places there were large, representative gatherings, every part of the respective provinces being represented. Our friends are in good heart, and are prepared to go enthusiastically into the work and effect the reorganization of the party in the respective provinces thoroughly. They are greatly strengthened by the last session of the House, when it was apparent that the Government was weak, divided, and unable to express any opinion on any question of special import or policy. The events of the session were clearly demonstrated to our friends that the Government is weak, containing elements of discord and disunity, and that the Liberal-Conservative party is in a position to overthrow it. All this shows that all that is required is energetic action on our part to carry out the program of the party. There is great gratification in business everywhere, caused by the prostration of the Government in declaring its tariff policy. Financiers are deterred from investing capital, and it is evident that all this will entail great suffering, especially to the working classes, during the coming winter."

Sir Charles' attention was drawn to the announcement that the Government intended to push public works during the coming winter so as to provide work for the unemployed. He replied, "but how can they do it? They have left themselves without a cent of money to do this, and they have not secured it. Speaking of the rise in the price of wheat, Sir Charles pointed out that it would prove of immense benefit, not only to the farmers of the Maritime Provinces, but also in helping the farmers, but also in largely assisting the Government, and thereby helping to settle the great debt of the west. He recognized that while the Government might be able to raise money at once set to work to prepare for the Ontario convention, which takes place at Toronto on the 27th inst.
