

SMALL RAIS UPON WALL ST.

Some Rather Heavy Realizing Took Place Yesterday

And There Were Some Marked Reactions in Many Issues—Later, However, Brought About Something of a Recovery, and the Day's Net Losses Were Not Heavy—Notes.

Friday Evening, Dec. 16. Consols eased off 1/16 in London today, but on that market American rails advanced 1/8 to 3/4 points, the latter gain being recorded by N. Y. C.

Wall-street stocks continued on the uptrend till morning, and new records were made in several issues. Late this afternoon quite a raft was made on the market. There was free selling and marked concessions in many issues.

Canadian securities continued steady to strong today. On the Toronto Exchange C. P. R. sold up to 87 1/2, and fell off later to 85 1/2. Western Assurance brought 25 1/2.

Stocks were very active on the Montreal Board. Montreal Gas, the chief feature, making another good advance.

In Paris 8 per cent. rates were at 102 1/2. French exchange on London, 257.00.

A dividend is expected on Rubber Company in January, but may be postponed to March. The company is earning 4 per cent. on the common stock, will be declared next week.
