Municipal Ownership is No Longer a Debated Question in the Great Metropolis.

ALL FRANCHISES TO BE ACQUIRED

For the Running of the Traction Cars by the Municipal Corporation by 1910.

London, May 24.—Municipal ownership of traction facilities in the metropolis was substantially extended by the London County Council when notice was served on the companies in the parishes of Deptford, Greenwich and Southwark requiring the surrender of their franchises, embracing 20 miles of tramways.
