NAPOLEON AND THE KAISER (Canadian Courier)

Every day resemblance between Em eror Napoleon and the Kaiser grown tronger. In 1810 France stretched from

stronger. In 1816 France stretched from the confines of Naples to the Baltic, Holland and Hanscatic towns having been the latest additions. It was possible to travel from Lubek to Rome without passing outside the boundaries of Napoleon's domain.

Shortly it may be possible to travel from Hamburg to Constantinople without passing outside the area controlled by the Kaiser's soldiers. Austria is virtually a vassal kingdom of the Prussian, and Bulgaria will shortly be dominated by the same impudent power.

Another comparison lies in the inevitable end of this attempt at world-conquest. Napoleon's final defeat was inevitable from his first campaign and so is the Kaiser's. Napoleon attempted the imposible and so did the Kaiser. Napoleon's Rusian expedition of 1812 has been much discussed in comparison with the Kaiser's Russian campaign of 1916. It remains to be seen whether the results will be the same, but at present it seems likely. The campaign in Bulgaria has its counterpart in Saxony in 1818. Napoleon's great victory at Dresden in August of that year only postponed the great defeat at Leipsic in October. The Kaiser may occupy Nish and join hands with the Turks, but his Leipsic will come sooner or later.

Between Napoleon's last victory at Dresden in August, 1818, and the occupation of Paris in March, 1814 there was only a period of five months. The downfall of the Kaiser may be less swift but it is equally certain. Will it be Elba or St. Helena?
