

MANITOBA LIQUOR LAW.

Amendment to the Inland Revenue Act so that "real punishment" might be meted out for breaches of the Temperance Law was urged by Major H. R. Richardson, Roblin, of the independent farmer group, when speaking in the Manitoba legislature last week, on the reply to the throne speech. So far from backing up the Moderation League in its efforts to get a referendum on the cstablishment of government liquor stores, Major Richardson took the stand that until some further efforts were made to stamp out the illicit sale, manufacture and consumption of liquor in the province, no petition for new legislation should be passed by the house.

The new administration will add appreciably to its credit if it succeds in finding a practical solution to a problem on which depends in a large measure the good management of the affairs of the metropolis."
