Newfoundland is looking to New Brunswick to supply potato seed for at least a portion of this season's potato crop, says the Frederickton Gleaner. Formerly Prince Edward Island supplied the greater bulk of Newfoundland's imported seed stock, but conditions this year have apparently forced the potato growers of the island to go farther afield.

Recently a communication was received by the Soils and Crops Division of the Provincial Department of Agriculture seeking to arrange for the purchase of at least one carload of New Brunswick's best seed stock for immediate shipment. Arrangements are being made to meet the request.

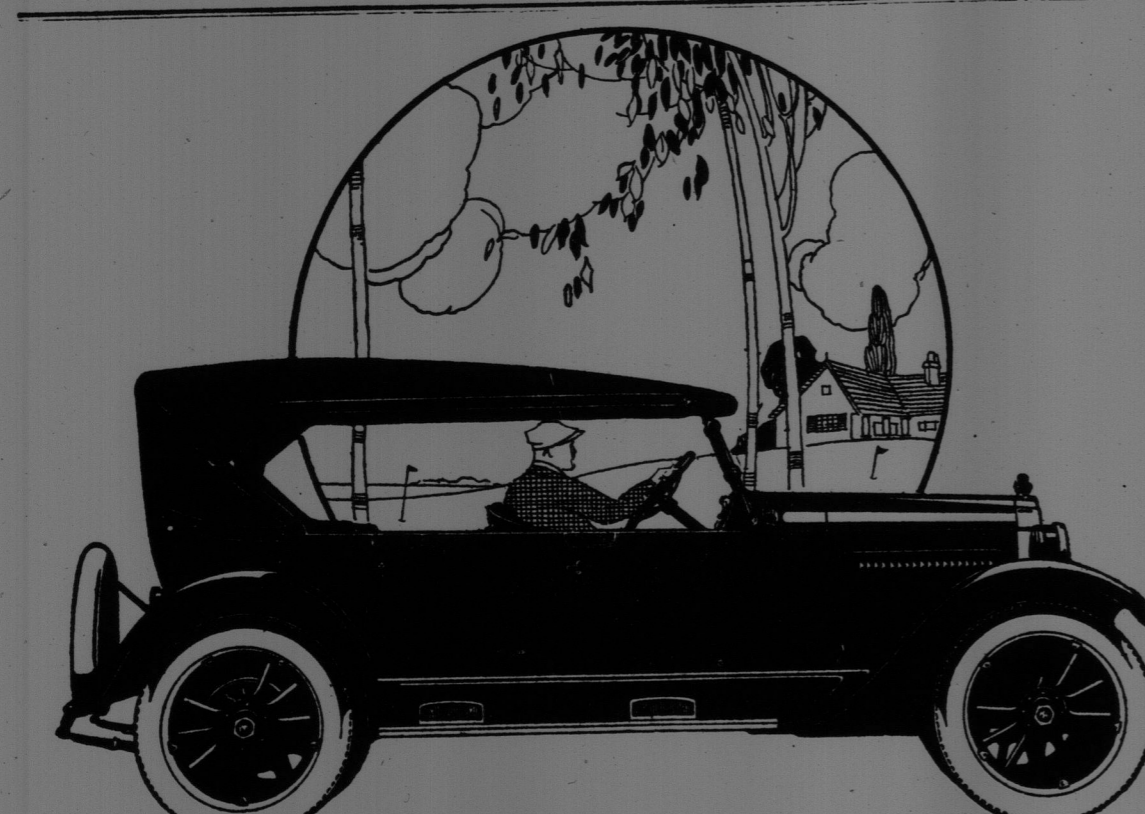
