Mine Detector Equipment

1. Reference your 55/3561/1 SDTD of 5th October, 1945.
2. Mine detector equipment as shown in the appendix to the a/m letter should be passed as a "free issue" to C.S.R.D.E., Ottawa. On receipt of this equipment, authority will be requested, under an established procedure, to pass the equipment on loan to the Department of Geology, University of Toronto, where it will be available for any purpose required by Major Russell.
3. With regard to the continued employment of Major Russell in an advisory capacity, no particular difficulty is foreseen in this regard, but any requirement should be passed through the normal channel of communication from the U.K. authorities via C.M.H.Q. to N.D.H.Q. (attention D.E.C.D.) with this procedure being reversed in the case of correspondence emanating from Major Russell.
