

Prospectus



Bourget College was founded at Rigaud, P. Q., in 1850, by the venerable Bishop I. Bourget and Mgr J. Desautels, and is under the direction of the Religious Community, the Clerics of St. Viator.

This Institution is pleasantly situated on the slope of a lofty mountain on the bank of a beautiful little river, two miles distant from the Ottawa River, in one of the most healthy and picturesque sections of the country, 45 miles from Montreal, and 80 miles from Ottawa City, on the Canadian Pacific Railroad.

The locality is unrivaled for pure bracing air and fresh mountain water, offering peculiar advantages to pupils even of delicate constitution.

The College is spacious, and supplied with modern conveniences, rendering the establishment no less contributive to health than the location and climate.

Extensive grounds afford every facility for the enjoyment of invigorating exercise.

The diet of the pupils is always very wholesome and abundant. In sickness they are watched over and treated with parental solicitude.

Communications.

The Communications with Bourget College are now very convenient, it being accessible by water or rail. In summer, a steamboat forms a daily Communication between Montreal, Rigaud and Ottawa.

Pupils coming from the West per "Grand Trunk RR." "Canadian Pacific RR." or "Canada Atlantic RR." take the Steamer "Sovereign" at St. Ann's or can change cars at Vaudreuil, P. Q., for Rigaud.
