The Committee on Home Missions and Colportage submit the following Report :-

1. This Association is deeply impressed with the immense importance of enlarged exertions in the Home Mission enterprise. It regards also the diffusion of the Sacred Scriptures and of religious books, and the establishment of Sabbath Schools for the instruction of the young as a most important element in Home Mission work; and would therefore recommend that the Constitution of the N B. the funds of the Society.

3.
