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On a Memorandum dated 14th. June, 1910, from the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs submitting that it being necessary to grade the approaches to bridge No 3 over McKenzie Creek, between lots 24 and 25, Concession 2, Township of Tuscarora, in the Six Nations Indian reserve, tenders were called for, and the council of the band has passed a resolution in favour of charging to their capital the amount of the tender of Mathew Claus, namely, \$275.00.
