"R. W. Deputy Grand Master, apply the Square to that portion of the Foundation Stone that needs to be proved, and make report."

Deputy Grand Master: "Most Worshipful, I find the Stone to be square."

"R. W. Senior Grand Warden, apply the Level to that portion of the Foundation Stone that needs to be proved, and make report,"

S. G. W.: "Most Worshipful, I find the Stone to be level."

"R. W. Junior Grand Warden, apply the Plumb to that portion of the Foundation Stone that needs to be proved, and make report."

J. G. W.: "Most Worshipful, I find the Stone to be plumb."

G. M.: "This Corner Stone, having been tested by the Square, Level and Plumb, I find that the craftsmen have skilfully and faithfully performed their duty, and I do declare the Stone to be well formed, true and trusty, and correctly laid, according to the rules of our ancient craft."

G. M.: "Let the elements of consecration now be presented."
