

Cartwright may be purchased at 10/Cy. per acre if such be the case they can be paid for without much inconvenience to the Indians.

The arrearages of annuity due to his people amount to about £300 which would pay for two thirds of the land in the Township of Cartwright without encroaching on the annuity for the current year and I have no doubt the present owner of the aforesaid land would be quite willing to wait for a reasonable time for the balance.

The proceeds of the sale of the tract at Balsam Lake could be invested to their use and thus add to their present annuity.
