An Act to amend an Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act to regulate the Culling and Measurement of Timber, Masts, Spars, Deals, Staves, and other Articles of a like nature.*" (See further, page 1249)

WHEREAS it is expedient to remove certain doubts which Preamble.
have been entertained, touching the intention of the Legislature, in relation to the Culling and Measuring of Deals ; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

5 That so much of the twenty-fourth Section of the Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to regulate the Culling and Measurement of Timber, Masts, Spars, Deals, Staves, and other Articles of a like nature,*" as is
10 conveyed and expressed by the words " or assorted," shall be and is hereby repealed, and that henceforward the said words " or assorted," in the said Section, shall be held and considered to form no part thereof.
