

An Act respecting the parishes of St. Eugène de Grantham, in the county of Drummond, and St. Nazaire d'Acton, in the county of Bagot.

WHEREAS, by chapter 45 of the statutes of 1879 of the Que., 1879, c. 45. Legislature of the Province of Quebec, that portion of the parish of St. Eugène de Grantham which lies in the county of Bagot was detached from the said county and
 5 annexed for all purposes to the county of Drummond, and the electors of the said portion of the said parish have since been disfranchised at Dominion elections in the county of Bagot; and whereas, by chapter 67 of the statutes of 1894 of the said Que., 1894, c. 67. Legislature, a portion of the parish of St. Nazaire d'Acton
 10 was detached from the county of Drummond and annexed to the county of Bagot, and the electors of the said portion of the said parish have since been disfranchised at Dominion elections in the county of Drummond : Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Com-
 15 mons of Canada, enacts as follows :—

1. For the purposes of Dominion elections, the parish of St. Elections in counties of Drummond and Bagot. Eugène de Grantham, as constituted by chapter 45 of the statutes of 1879 of the Legislature of the Province of Quebec, shall form part of the county of Drummond, and the parish of
 20 St. Nazaire d'Acton, as constituted by chapter 67 of the statutes of 1894 of the said Legislature, shall form part of the county of Bagot, and the voters' lists prepared for the said parishes shall be used.
