acted by the Authority aforesaid, That the Bounties granted by the befoze recited Ad, made in the Kifteenth Pear of His Wajetty's Reign, thall be allowed for luch Uchiels as have been fitted and cleared out fince the First Dap of January, One thousand seven hundred and seventy-nine, or wall be hereafter fitted and cleared out, in the Manner directed by the faid Act, during the mesent postilities, from and after the said Kirst Day of January in each Pear, and which thall return to some Port in England on or before the Thirty-first Day of December in the next succeeding Bear; and that the Bounties granted by another Ad, made in the Sirteenth Bear of Dis Majesty's Reign, (intituled, An Act 16 co. 111, for the further Encouragement of the Whale Fishery carried on from Great Britain and Ireland, and the British Dominions in Europe; and for regulating the Fees to be taken by the Officers of the Customs in the Island of Newfoundland), thall be allowed for such Clesses as thall be fitted and cleared out, in the Wanner directed by that Ad, during the present Hollisties, from and after the First Day of January in each Pear, and which shall return to some Port in England on or before the Thirty: first Day of December in the next succeeding Pear; any Thing in the herein-before recited Ads, or either of them, to the contrary notwith anding; but the said leveral respective Bounties shall, in all other Respects not hereby altered, be subject and liable to the same Rules. Regulations, and Rectrictions, as if this Act had not been made.
