This Indenture made the twenty second day of November in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty two between Walter Fraser (an Indian of the Mohawk tribe) of Mount Pleasant, on the Grand River Tract, District of Gore and Province of Upper Canada of the one part and Christopher Misner (Yeoman) of the other part Witnesseth that the said Walter Fraser for and in consideration of the Yearly rents covenants and agreements herein after made and contained and on the part and behalf of the said Christopher Misner, his heirs or assigns to be paid, observed and performed hath demised granted and to have and to hold by these presents doth demise, grant and to have and to hold unto the said Christopher Misner, his heirs or assigns, all that certain farm piece or parcel of land situate lying and being on a certain tract or territory of land on the Grand River in the Province aforesaid now in the possession of the six nations of Indians residing thereon and, the same known and described as follows that is to say, and the east side of the road leading from Brantford to Long Point, on the south side or bank of the said River and at the north west angle of the farm now in the possession and occupancy of Erastus Benedict and running thence in company with said Benedict's eastern line south six degrees east ninety chains, thence North eighty four degrees east twenty two chains, thence North six degrees west to the bank of said River thence up the said River to the place of beginning or first mentioned boundary containing two hundred acres of Land more or less. Together with all and singular the benefits liberties privileges and appurtenance to the said premises belonging; To have and to hold the said demised premises with the appurtenances unto the said Christopher Misner his heirs or assigns from the day of the date of these presents for, and during and until the full and entire term of twenty one Years thence next ensuing and fully to be completed and ended; Yielding and paying therefore yearly and every year during the said term of years the said Walter Fraser his heirs or assigns the
