Dear Sir:

Your letter of the 20th. of November last was received during my absence, this is the reason why I have been so long in answering it.

The Quebec Act for the Compensation to working men passed during last Session in Quebec will come on effect only on the 1st. of Jan. 1910. I believe that the Law is just for the employe and the employer as it has not been yet on effect.

I could not say what changes are desirable I believe it could be extended to all employment except farmers hand; it was opposed in our Legislature, and I do not believe you could have it passed in yours.
