Rev. Sir,-

I return herewith the following accounts which have recently been received from you, and have to request that you will kindly state the circumstances under which the lumber, etc. therein charged for was supplied.

If the Indians who received the building material had houses which were destroyed you should say whether they were burned on account of smallpox ^{or tuberculosis} or in order that new and more sanitary houses might be erected:-

An account, rendered at \$15.00, from Mr. Alfred D. Barry, for lumber supplied to Stephen Peter.

An account, rendered at \$7.00, from Messrs. Bent & Cohen, for building material furnished to Sally Paul; also an account, rendered at \$16.40, for lumber supplied Sally Paul by Mr. John Veir. In this connection you should state the total expenditure for lumber on behalf of this person.

An account, rendered at \$20.00, from Messrs. D. Fullerton & Son, for lumber supplied Peter Sapier. An account, amounting to \$51.17, from Messrs. Donald Grant & Sons, for lumber furnished to Frank Bernard and Peter Sapier. The total expenditure on Sapier's behalf should also be shown.

An account, rendered at \$6.00, from Messrs. John J. Grant, for lumber supplied Francis St. Pierre.

An account, from Geo. Milne, for lumber to the value of \$28.00, furnished Frank Sapier.

An account from Alfred D. Barry for lumber to the value of \$15.00 furnished Abraham Paul.

An account, amounting to \$25.50, from Messrs. D. Fullerton & Sons, for lumber supplied Noel Toney.

An account, rendered at \$25.25, for lumber furnished to Frank Goss, by Alfred D. Barry.
